

## Instructions for Poster Presenters

As the SiliconPV Conference 2025 together with the nPV Workshop are getting closer, we would like to provide you with the guidance on how to prepare your poster.

This document contains important information for poster presenters. Please read these instructions carefully and follow them accordingly.

Onsite Registration is mandatory for all poster presenters. If an author (or co-author) is not registered, the presentation will not be included in the conference program and the paper is not eligible for publication in the proceedings.

### Presentations for Internal Area

All poster presenters may upload their poster in PDF format to the Internal Area for all registered participants to view. You may upload it in DIN A4 format with a good display quality.

### General information

- Poster authors are requested to bring the printed poster to the conference in DIN A0 portrait size format by themselves.
- Please see the [detailed program](#) for the time of the poster sessions. All times are shown in British Summer Time (BST).
- Please be available at your poster during the relevant poster session for questions and discussion

### We ask poster authors to take care of the following:

- You are responsible for printing your poster in advance and for putting it up at the conference. It is not possible to print your poster at the venue.
- Your poster should be with a maximum size of DIN A0 format portrait size.
- Please make sure that letters are sufficiently large to be read from a distance of 1-3 m.
- Please mount your poster on **Tuesday morning, April 8**. Mounting material will be provided.
- In order to find the spot where your poster should be mounted, appropriate signs will be put up on each poster wall indicating the author's name, poster title, and poster number. If you have difficulties finding your assigned poster spot at the conference site, please seek out one of our staff members and we will be happy to assist you.
- Please do not remove your poster before the conference ends. The posters are an integral part of the scientific program and should be displayed the entire time.
- Please remove your poster directly after the closing session at the latest. Posters remaining after the conference has ended **will be discarded**.

### Conference Registration
